- 1. TURN OFF ALL CYLINDERS
- 2. DISCONNNECT ALL CYLINDERS
- 3. DISCONNECT OUTLET PIPE
- 4. ENSURE ALL PRESSURE IS RELIEVED FROM UNIT
- 5. UNSCREW OPSO PROTECTION CAP
- 6. PULL OPSO PIN INTO SET POSITION
- 7. REPLACE PROTECTION CAP
- 8. RE-CONNECT CYLINDERS
- 9. RE-CONNECT THE OUTLET PIPE
- 10. ENSURE THAT THE OUTLET BALLVALVE IS OPEN
- 11. NOTE THE POSITION OF THE BLACK SUPPLY ARROW
- 12. <u>SLOWLY</u> TURN ON THE CYLINDER THAT THIS ARROW IS NOT POINTING TO.
- 13. TURN THE ARROW ROUND TO FACE THE OTHER CYLINDER
- 14. <u>SLOWLY</u> TURN ON THE CYLINDER THAT THIS ARROW IS NOT POINTING TO

IF THE GAS SHOULD RUN OUT THE PROCEDURE MAY NEED TO BE REPEATED.
